Stroll among the homes of some of the city's early leaders in retailing, consumer goods and emerging industries that would eventually take them up the hills to the suburbs.

Starts at 1 pm from The Betts House, 416 Clark Street.

CLIFTON

Town and Gown, The ABCs of Cincinnati's Academic Enclave Aesthetics and activism, Beauty and bombast, Castles and castigators. That's what you get in a community focused on self-sufficiency. Just three miles from the center of the city lies **Clifton** that fought 19th century annexation and 20th century infiltration of franchises.

Starts from the corner of Middleton and Rawson Woods.

WALNUT HILLS

Cables, Inclines and Streetcars, Oh My!! What was the price of a ride up Gilbert Avenue? Did the location of the Lane Seminary help support a large African American community? Was this the first place where religious diversity flourished? The growth and evolution of **Walnut Hills** is important in the history of Cincinnati.

Starts from Parkside Cafe, 1026 E McMillan Street.

EAST WALNUT HILLS

The Swiss Chalet, Apartments for the Middle Classes, an Eclectic Community - That is **East Walnut Hills**. Across Victory Parkway and down Woodburn Avenue, with jogs along side streets with imaginative and beautiful residences, you will see the extension of a community as transportation expanded.

Starts from Parkside Cafe, 1026 E McMillan Street.
